- A. 6VAC15-40 Minimum Standards for Jails and Lockups
  - Administration and Management Mary-Huffard Kegley The Committee reviewed the Administration and Management workgroup's recommendations for minimum standards. The Committee requested Board staff to consider grievance procedures and develop language for consideration.

- Health/Mental Health Alison Lautz The Committee reviewed the Health/Mental Health workgroup's recommendations for minimum standards. The Committee requested Board staff to convene the workgroup for consideration of several issues.
- Food Services Paul Beaupre The Committee agreed with the Food Services workgroup's recommendations for minimum standards.
- B. The Committee supported maintenance of Guidance Documents to provide clarity:
  - 1. Compliance Documentation for Jails effective January 1, 2015 audits.
  - 2. Compliance Documentation for Lockups effective July 1, 2013.
  - 3. BLRJ Policy 30-3 Inmate Deaths:

Mr. McCord shared the Office of the Attorney General's guidance regarding inmate death investigations. The Board has the authority to investigate inmate deaths if the inmate is in custody in the hospital. The Board does not have the authority to investigate inmate deaths if the inmate is on furlough or compassionate release.
